- All submitted applications will be received in the Site Registration Received status
- Upon review, it will either be approved and moved into Site Registration Approved status or rejected and moved into Site Registration Error status
- If approved:
 - Project will move to Site Registration Approved status.
 - Rater and Builder will receive a letter of commitment and the project will then move to Site Registration Complete status.
- If rejected:
 - Project will move into Site Registration Error status
 - Rater and Builder will receive a reason for the rejection, and will be expected to make any corrections



Pre-Drywall & Final Inspection Process

- Complete the Rater Inspection Notification Workbook with scheduled inspections dates/times as soon as they are available and follow directions in the workbook to email to the RNC team
- Use the Portal to upload inspection results
- All failed inspections must be uploaded to the corresponding milestone and subsequent pass reports must be updated to advance the workflow
 - For all failed inspections, the inspection re-scheduling process would start over again
- Please schedule all inspections the day before by 3pm, using the Rater Inspection Notification Workbook
- If inspections have passed, you may upload them at this point, but they
 are not required until you are ready to submit your File Review (aka iApp)
 at the final stage of the project.

Internal Quality Assurance Verification

All inspection requests shall be reported using the Inspection Notification Workbook (see following pages) so that our QA team can put them into a daily pool to randomly "select" or "waive" to inspect these projects along with the Rater. If the project is selected, our inspection team will reach out to the Rater listed on the form to coordinate the site visit.



File Review Process

- Submit all documentation and update the final savings information for the Incentive Application once your project has reached the File Review milestone
- Once submitted, it will then be reviewed by the assigned Program Specialist
- If approved, the project will move to the Payment status and sent for review by the BPU
- If rejected, the project will move into the File Review Error status, and you will be notified of any deficiencies that need to be fixed. You will have until the expiration date to make necessary revisions
- Any funds committed to the project will be terminated once it expires
- Please allow up 120 days from the date the NJCEP approval is issued to receive payment

Internal Quality Assurance Verification

Like inspection requests, our QA team will randomly "select" or "waive" your File Review applications so they can perform a final document review of these projects to ensure our program is operating at it's best.





