The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (NJBPU or Board) is proposing to amend its existing Transition Incentive Program (TI Program) rules to improve the implementation of the TI Program based on lessons learned from program implementation since May 1, 2020. The rulemaking was published in the August 2, 2021 issue of the New Jersey Register and is also available on the Board's website at www.nj.gov/bpu/agenda/rules.
